



## Foley Infant Academy Sports Premium Spending 2020-2021

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by central government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. Each year the school receive a lump sum per eligible pupil which is £17,130 for Foley Infant Academy for 2020-2021.

At our school, the money is being used in the following ways:

- 1) To give staff an opportunity to work alongside PE specialists to improve quality of PE lessons and to raise fitness levels.
- 2) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils and to give our children a sense of belonging to the house teams establishes across school.
- 3) To increase engagement in sports and inspire our children to participate fully in PE lessons and the wider community competitions.
- 4) To develop the subject leadership of PE across the school.
